Guide for annual evaluation of the doctoral student's supervision and work situation

The guide should be a tool to facilitate an evaluation of the doctoral student's supervision and work situation. Before the discussion, which should preferably take place in connection with the update of the study plan, both the doctoral student and the supervisor(s) should go through the questions on their own and tick off the options below that best describe the situation they experienced. The extent to which the follow-up questions should be discussed should be guided by the answers to the initial questions.

What is the overall experience of the main supervisor's supervision?

Is there good transparency and honesty between the parties?

What external support is available for the doctoral student (department, head of department, representative, etc.)?

Division of responsibilities

How clear is the division of responsibilities between supervisor and doctoral student?

Who is responsible for scheduling supervision meetings?

How well integrated does the doctoral student feel in the research group he/she is part of?
